## CONFERINTA NATIONALA ARTS, LA A IV-A EDITIE

Buna dimineata Doamnelor si Domnilor,

Stimati membri ARTS,

Stimati oaspeti,

Privind aceasta distinsa adunare si interesul de care s-a bucurat acest eveniment, nu pot sa spun decat ca incerc un sentiment de mandrie ca sunt membru al ARTS.

In 10 ani, ARTS a reusit sa polarizeze atentia tuturor partilor interesate de tehnica si de piata de securitate din Romania.

Chiar daca inceputurile au fost timide si ezitante, an de an, ARTS a capatat credibilitatea si forta unei asociații serioase si competente, atat pentru membri cat si pentru partenerii sai.

De 4 ani suntem membri ai EURALARM, asociatia europeana a producatorilor si integratorilor de tehnica de securitate din Europa. De-a lungul celor, iata, 42 de ani de existenta, Euralarm s-a focusat in special pe elaborarea si promovarea standardelor pentru echipamente si pe crearea unui sistem unitar, european de conformitate a produselor, EQM. ( European Quality Mark).

Munca si dedicatia multor generatii de ingineri, manageri si specialisti stau in spatele acestor standarde europene pe care azi, cu totii ni le asumam si incercam sa le folosim din respect si consideratie pentru clientii nostri si pentru calitatea muncii noastre.

Dar pentru ca acum Europa este o mare familie, o piata unica, pentru ca frontierele vor ramane doar simboluri ale trecutului, iata ca din 2006 avem o Directiva Europeana a Serviciilor care a recomandat elaborarea unor standarde de servicii care sa uniformizeze calitatea acestora in toate tarile membre EU.

Infiintarea acum 4 ani a sectiunii de servicii a Euralarm a adus un echilibru binevenit in abordarea si definirea calitatii sistemelor electronice de securitate. S-a dovedit ca aceasta sectiune era veriga care lipsea, ca nu se mai putea vorbi numai de calitatea si performanta echipamentelor si ca serviciile mai mult ca oricand, acum, intr-o piata europeana, joaca un rol foarte important in ansamblul tehnicii de securitate. De aceea, demararea elaborarii standardelor de servicii, pregatirea cadrelor de specialitate, atestarea si certificarea acestora reprezinta preocupari importante atat pentru ARTS cat si pentru EURALARM.

ARTS s-a bucurat inca din primul an cand a aderat de atentia si interesul conducerii EURALARM. In 2009 si 2010, CN ale ARTS au avut invitati de marca din partea Euralarm prin domnii Marc Chabaud, Jos van Kampen si Dirk Gesenhues. In 2011, ARTS a fost gazda AG a EURALARM, organizata la Bucuresti. Cu ocazia acestor evenimente dar nu numai, reprezentantii autoritatilor romane de reglementare au luat cunostinta de tendintele europene din zona tehnicii de securitate, au purtat discutii cu reprezentantii Euralarm si au prezentat pozitia Romaniei fata de aceste tendinte.

Ne bucuram sa remarcam eforturile ARTS ca membru EURALARM de promovare si sustinere a tendintelor europene in diferitele ocazii pe care le-am avut; ca parteneri de dialog in elaborarea noilor norme ale legii 333, in elaborarea proiectului de lege privind Securitatea privata, in sustinerea si promovarea noului standard de servicii european, in promovarea conceptului EQM – CERTALARM, etc.

Pe linia preocuparilor privind acceptarea si sustinerea standardelor europene, ARTS a preluat secretariatul CT 27 sisteme de alarma, din cadrul ASRO, specialisti din partea membrilor nostri, muncind la adaptarea in limba romana si la armonizarea acestora.

Si ca o continuare, in 2012, CN a ARTS are ca oaspeti din nou, personalitati marcante ale EURALARM: noul presedinte al organizatiei, d-l Marc Chabaud ne face onoarea de a fi prezent la Bucuresti la numai 2 saptamani de la investirea in functie; D-l Enzo Peduzzi noul Presedinte al sectiunii de servicii si Vicepresedinte al Euralarm; d-l Paul Langer, Presedintele CT 4 privind elaborarea standardelor europene de servicii al CENELEC; d-l Hans Leijendekkers, ambasador al CERTALARM marca de calitate pentru echipamentele si serviciile de securitate a Europei de maine. Din motive obiective, D-l Carlo Loi, Presedinte al CT 79 al CENELEC a anulat in ultima clipa deplasarea la Bucuresti dar a tinut sa trimita CN a ARTS prezentarea domniei sale.

Le multumim tuturor pentru efortul si onoarea pe care ne-o fac sa fie prezenti astazi la Bucuresti. Conferinta de astazi face parte dintr-un program de conferinte tematice pe axa Bucuresti- Sofia, sub egida Euralarm si au ca scop punerea in lumina a Directivei europene a Serviciilor si cum se poate ea transpune in legislatiile nationale ale tarilor membre. De aceea, la evenimentul nostru avem ca invitati si delegatia din Bulgaria din partea asociatiei NAFOTS, reprezentata de D-l Presedinte Stefan Gankov si D-na Tatyana Ivanova, secretar executiv. Good morning Ladies and Gentlemen,  
Respected ARTS members,  
Dear guests,

On this distinguished assembly and interests that this event has enjoyed, I can only say that I am experiencing a pride feeling of being an ARTS member.

In 10 years, ARTS succeeded in polarizing the attention of all interested parties of technical and security market in Romania.

Even though the beginnings were cautious and hesitant, with every year, ARTS has gained credibility and strength of a serious and competent society, both for its members and partners.

We have been members of EURALARM for four years, the European association of manufacturers and integrators of security technology in Europe. Along 40 years of existence, Euralarm has especially focused on developing and promoting high standards for equipments and on creating a unitary European system for quality.

The work and dedication of several generations of engineers, managers and specialists are behind those European standards, that today we are undertaking and trying to use them out of respect and consideration for our clients and for our work quality.

But now Europe is one big family, a single market, because the borders will remain only symbols of the past. Since 2006 we have a European Service Directive that recommended the development of standards for the uniformization of quality services in all EU States.

The establishment, about 4 years ago of service section of Euralarm, brought a balance in approaching and defining of electronic security systems quality. It turned out that this section was the missing link and we could not only speak of quality and performance of equipment but the service, more than ever now, in a European market, has an important role in all security projects. Therefore, drawing up standards of services, specialized staff training, their certification and certification are important concerns for both ARTS and EURALARM.

ARTS has enjoyed, since the first year when joining EURALARM, getting the attention and interest of EURALARM leaders. In 2009 and 2010, the ARTS NC had important guests from Euralarm, such as Mr. Marc Chabaud, Jos van Kampen and Dirk Gesenhues. In 2011, ARTS hosted EURALARM GA, organized in Bucharest. On the occasion of these events, but not limited to, representatives of the Romanian authorities have taken notice of regulatory trends in the European security technique, have held summit talks with representatives of Euralarm and presented Romania's position towards these trends.

We are glad to note that ARTS's efforts as a member of EURALARM to promote and support European trends in different occasions that we had, as dialogue partners in developing new application forms of law 333, in drafting the new private security law, in supporting and promoting the new European standards of services, in promoting the concept EQM - CERTALARM, etc..

Peduzzi, the new Chairman of the services section and Vice-President of Euralarm; Mr. Paul Langer, Chairman of CT 4 concerning the development of European standards for services; Hans Leijendekkers, Ambassador of CERTALARM, the quality brand for security equipment and services for tomorrow's Europe. For objective reasons, Mr. Carlo Loi, 'President of TC 79 of CENELEC, cancelled at the last minute the trip to Bucharest, but wanted to send to NC ARTS his presentation.

We want to thank everyone for their effort and for the honour of having them, today, in Bucharest.

Today's conference is part of a program of thematic conferences, axis Bucharest-Sofia, under Euralarm brand and aim to promote the low European Services Directive and how to implement it in national legislation of the member countries. Therefore, at this event we invited the delegation of Bulgaria from NAFOTS Association, represented by Mr. President Stefan Gankov and Ms. Tatyana Ivanova, Executive Secretary. Also, the Bulgarian police authorities are represented by Mr. Commissioner Nikolay Grigorov. I want to welcome them and thank them for their presence them in our conference.

Finally, I want to extend special thanks to those who responded positively to the request ARTS presentations on topics requested and have spent their precious time in their development.
